We have no indoor workshop spaces this year, as there are no enclosed buildings onsite. However, there are multiple canopy-type shelters approximately 25x40 feet in size with picnic tables available. If your proposal is for a workshop or event that would occur at an unusual time or location, or for a different time length, we will do our best to accommodate it.

If you were a presenter last year, we encourage you to present something new this year if possible.
